### CONTROL OF SUBSTANCES HAZARDOUS TO HEALTH

<b>Domestic Cleaning Materials</b>			
<b>Constituents</b>	See container	<b>Hazards</b>	May be Hazardous and/or Flammable
<b>Usage</b>	Small quantities for domestic type cleaning. A more thorough assessment will be required if large quantities (10litres) are to be used	<b>Disposal</b>	Do not allow to enter drains, rivers or watercourses Dispose of in domestic refuse
<b>Precautions</b>	1. Follow manufacturers instructions	<b>Spillage</b>	Wipe up and dispose of in normal refuse
<b>1. Checks</b>	1. Read instructions on the label	<b>First Aid</b>	
<b>2. Storage</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Keep in original containers</li> <li>2. Keep containers tightly closed and upright</li> <li>3. Keep away from children and animals.</li> <li>4. Ensure all containers clearly marked</li> </ol>	<b>Inhalation (Breathing)</b> Move person to fresh air immediately. Administer artificial respiration if necessary. Obtain medical attention.	<b>Ingestion (Swallowed)</b> Do NOT induce vomiting Give water to drink Obtain medical attention
		<b>Skin contact</b>	Wash with soap and water.
		<b>Eyes</b>	Flush with water for at least 10 minutes. Obtain medical attention
