Timber Treatments and Paints			
Constituents	See container	Hazards	May be Hazardous and/or Flammable
Usage	Preservative and decorative treatment of wood.	Disposal	Do not allow to enter drains, rivers or watercourses Dispose of through a licensed waste disposal contractor
Precautions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Use only in well ventilated areas. 2. With some timber treatments it is necessary to wear a coverall, gloves, eye protection. 3. Do not eat drink or smoke during use. 	Spillage	<p>If flammable Eliminate all sources of ignition</p> <p>Avoid inhaling vapour, use a respirator if necessary. Absorb on sand and sweep up.</p>

Ensure all containers clearly marked 	Inhalation (Breathing)	Move person to fresh air immediately. Administer artificial respiration if necessary. Obtain medical attention.
		Ingestion (Swallowed)	Do NOT induce vomiting Give water to drink Obtain medical attention
		Skin contact	Wash with soap and water.
		Eyes	Flush with water for at least 10 minutes. Obtain medical attention
