

Colours and Markings

How to play the game:

Individually draw the outline and shade the white area of each marking onto the pony's face and legs.

As a team answer the questions on colours and markings.

Equipment:

Table and 6 chairs

Individual answer sheets with face outline and leg outlines on.

Team answer sheet with questions on.

Answer legend

Pens for teams x6

Clipboard and pen for volunteers running table.

Stapler

2 volunteers

Tips for organisers:

Explain to the competitors that they need to draw the facial and leg markings onto the images.

Ensure that they are all sitting on opposite sides of the table and ask them to turn the pages upside down as soon as finished so that you can collect them. They can then move on to the team questions and answer the questions on the team sheet. When they are working on the team questions, they may all sit/stand together.

Remind them not to talk among themselves during the first part and to keep going until they are finished or the whistle blows.

Explain to them that they can have any of the questions read out to them if they prefer.

One volunteer collects and lays out score sheets while the second volunteer keeps the next team a few steps back from the table and explains the game to them.

Once the next team is taking part, one person checks the scores on each sheet. As a volunteer, all you need to do is score the sheets. Don't worry about adding up/working out the combined score.

Scoring

There are two parts to this round, an individual sheet to be marked out of 6 x3/4 depending on team members. Then a team sheet to be marked out of 14.

Add all the individual sheets together and divide by 3/4 depending on the number of members, to get a number between 0-6. Add that number to the team score and you will have a total round score out of 20.
