

How to play the game:

Tips for organisers:

Tell the teams that they may talk among themselves. Remind the teams to write their Branch/
Centre name and number on the sheet.
They must put their pens down at the final whistle.
There is only one answer to be selected per question if teams put more than one answer down
score the first answer written.
Score the answers against the legend, second person double check and initial the score.
