Constituents	Tar Distillates	Hazards	Hazardous
Usage	Treatment of timber	Disposal	Do not allow to enter drains, rivers or watercourses Dispose of through a licensed waste disposal contractor.
Precautions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Use only in well ventilated areas. 2. Wear coverall, gloves, eye protection. 3. Do not eat drink or smoke during use. 	Spillage	Avoid inhaling vapour, use a respirator if necessary. Absorb on sand and sweep up.
Checks	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Read instructions on the label 	First Aid	
Storage	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Keep containers tightly closed and upright 2. Keep away from children and animals. 3. Ensure all containers clearly marked 	Inhalation (Breathing)	Move person to fresh air immediately. Administer artificial respiration if necessary. Obtain medical attention.
		Ingestion (Swallowed)	Do NOT induce vomiting Give water to drink Obtain medical attention
		Skin contact	Wash with soap and water.
		Eyes	Flush with water for at least 10 minutes. Obtain medical attention as soon as practicable.
